Effective 7/15/2026 short side service for residential (5/8"x 3/4") meter sets are **\$1650.00**. Long side service (road crossing) for residential meter sets are **\$2300**. These amounts do include a \$50 deposit. Commercial deposits will be more. The cost for any larger meter sets will be determined by the District Manager. If an extension is needed, applicant will pay all construction, engineering, and legal expenses of such extension. Payments of such cost shall be made in advance to the District, or at the discretion of the Board of Directors, may be placed in a special escrow account. If the cost and expense of such construction is not ascertainable, the cost therefore shall be estimated and said amount shall be paid to the District or put into a special escrow account and the applicant shall agree to pay any additional cost incurred for such extension. Rock clause applies to all applications. In regards to the meter set, with any road crossing, the meter set shall be set approximately five feet inside the property line, of the property it shall serve. In regards to a short side service, the meter shall be placed within five feet of the water main. All meter sets are required to be within thirty feet of the edge of the driveway to the property being served, in a maintained area. The District will provide a 3/4-inch tail out from the meter set for the Customer to connect to. If Customer's line is ran to the point of contact, District will connect line as a courtesy. The District is only responsible for the 3/4-inch tail, not the fittings. The District recommends that a pressure reducing valve be installed in the home or business in areas which the pressure at the water main exceeds 50 psi.
